Our Mission is..

To provide safe shelter for homeless adults in a community setting while they are working to obtain stable housing.

CUE is a transitional mobile encampment and self-managed outside community hosted by faith community partners in the Eastside King County area.

The CUE community fosters resilience, relationships, self-confidence, and hope. CUE provides a safe place to stay and take steps out of homelessness.

Each member here is a responsible and active part of keeping CUE running with the support and oversight of a volunteer board of directors. We offer residents a safe place to reside, shower, and eat. To defray operating costs, campers pay a monthly maintenance fee of \$30. In this way we empower our camp and each other to be contributors.

AMENITIES

Campers are provided with:

- A personal & private tent
- Access to washer and dryer
- Access to shower
- Hot meals
- Transportation for medical needs at no charge
- Use of office computer for medical, work, & social service needs

Camp Unity is generously supported by a variety of volunteers, faith communities, and businesses. We have a good supply of donations that are available for all residents.



PROCESS TO APPLY

For our safety and our neighbors' safety, all potential new campers will be asked to complete a health checklist and pass a Warrant and Sex Offender check. We enforce a Code of Conduct and camp rules that every camper must follow.

All applicants must:

- Be at least 18 years of age
- Possess valid Washington or other state's ID (driver's license or ID card.) Passports and BIA IDs are not accepted.
- Be free of any outstanding warrants (including non-extraditable out-ofstate warrants)
- Be free of any sex offender status
- Be free of any no-contact or temporary restraining orders against current CUE residents
- Be physically capable of walking around on their own power and lifting up to 20-40 pounds

CUE is a drug & alcohol free camp, including all forms of marijuana. Weapons are not allowed.

CUE does not allow pets or emotional support animals.

New campers must successfully complete a two week probationary period. During the first week of probation, campers must spend each night in camp, and complete one four-hour security shift per day.

There is an interview as part of the intake process.
